# **Single Preferred Drug List**

Effective July 1, 2024, the state of South Carolina is moving to a single, state-directed pharmacy benefit preferred drug list (PDL). The PDL will be based on the SCDHHS current fee-for-service (FFS) PDL, which is available on the pharmacy section of SCDHHS' website.

- Individuals who have been prescribed medications prior to July 1, 2024, will be permitted to continue those agents for the duration of the current prescription or through December 31, 2024.
- A list of frequently asked questions (FAQs) is available on the website's pharmacy section.
- SCDHHS will host two live provider training webinars on Wednesday, May 22, 2024, 7:30-9:00 a.m. and 12:30-2:00 p.m. Registration information for the webinars, updates to the FAQs, and other provider training resources will be announced in a subsequent SCDHHS provider bulletin. - The single PDL is not a comprehensive list of all medications covered by Medicaid.
- In addition, in accordance with SCDHHS requirements, Select Health will move to zero copays for all prescriptions, effective July 1, 2024.

## May is Foster Care Awareness Month



Select Health has been the **exclusive Medicaid MCO** for **children in foster care** in South Carolina since 2012. The Select Health Foster Care Team includes an expert pediatrician, skilled RNs, social workers, care connectors, and resource coordinators. Team members **have specialized training and experience in motivational interviewing**, Mental Health First Aid, Mandt System® (behavioral crisis interaction training), person-centered thinking, and substance use disorders.

The team works with SCDHHS and South Carolina Department of Social Services (SCDSS) caseworkers and foster parents to help guide them in:

- Finding behavioral health providers and making appointments.
- Finding primary care providers (PCPs) and making well-child visit appointments.
- Help with BabyNet referrals.
- Scheduling transportation for appointments.
- Finding a dentist through DentaQuest.
- Pharmacy questions, and much, much more, including our new **Taking Flight program** to help **17-year-olds** as they age out of the foster care system.

## **Benefit Update Reminders**

In accordance with SCDHHS guidelines, the following benefits were added to coverage for First Choice members.

- Nucleic acid amplification test (NAAT) effective January 1, 2024
  SCDHHS has added coverage for NAAT when performed by qualified lab providers. NAAT is covered for the diagnosis of bacterial vaginosis for First Choice members and those enrolled in the Medicaid FFS Family Planning Limited-benefit program.
- Oncotype DX breast cancer coverage effective March 1, 2024
  SCDHHS has added coverage for Oncotype 81519 DX Breast Cancer Assay, a genetic test used for gene expression profiling by real-time RT-PCR of 21 genes, utilizing formalin-fixed paraffin embedded tissue. One test per lifetime is covered. ### Neuropharmacogenomic testing effective March 1, 2024

Neuropharmagen is a pharmacogenetic test (PGx) that allows providers to see how patients would interact with different medications for mental health diagnosis without going through a trial-and-error process to determine optimal medication and dosage. The test is available to adult First Choice members with prior authorization and must meet state criteria. ### **Other Important Reminders**

#### Change Healthcare update: Remittance advice payment recovery details now available!

Select Health is pleased to inform you that a solution has been developed in collaboration with Change Healthcare/Optum to provide payment recovery details on the remittance advice or 835 you receive with your payments for claims processed on and after May 6, 2024.

For claims processed February 21, 2024, through May 5, 2024, Select Health has generated a comprehensive claims recovery report available in the <u>NaviNet provider portal</u>. The claims recovery report provides payment recovery details by member account number, claim number, provider tax ID, payee/group ID, and NPI.

To access the claims recovery report:

- Log in to the NaviNet provider portal.
- Choose Select Health of South Carolina.
- Go to Report Inquiry, under Workflows for this Plan.
- Click on Administrative Reports>Claim Recovery Report.

#### Reminder: Prior authorization – current procedural technology (CPT) online lookup tool

You can easily find out if a service needs <u>prior authorization</u> by using the CPT lookup tool on our website. No need to call – using the CPT lookup tool is as easy as 1-2-3!

- 1. Enter a CPT/HCPCS code.
- 2. Click the submit button.
- 3. The tool will tell you if that service needs prior authorization as of the day queried.

#### **NaviNet Provider Portal**
